Community Days

Held in DuBois City Park, DuBois Community Days offer fun for the entire family. This year, Community Days begins on Friday June 14th at 5:00 PM. The celebration continues through Saturday, June 15th with a Firemen's Parade at 5:00 PM and fireworks when darkness descends. Expect to experience terrifically fun games, a wide variety of food and live performances by musicians, magicians and other enchanting performance artists. You and your loved ones will be inspired to sing, dance, laugh and play. Best of all, Community Days is free to attend. Note that some food and merchandise are for sale, but vendors here are non-profit organizations raising money for good causes, so if you have money to spend, consider spending it here. If you don't, just come and enjoy.

Hosted by the DuBois Volunteer Fire Department to thank the community it serves, Community Days is *the* event of the DuBois summer season. Last year, more than 10,000 people traversed the festival, stopping at its more than 70 booths to share fun, food and conversation. Businesses who participate -- often so that they can be seen by a multitude of people -- pay a fee. Monies raised this year will be used to fund next year's event.

Brockway Old Fashioned Fourth of July Celebration

The Brockway Old Fashioned Fourth of July event celebrates its 47th year delighting visitors with entertainment, races, food, fun and of course, fireworks. Leading into the main event on the Fourth, other happenings that may be of interest to you and your family are available.

The Brockway Historical Museum opens its doors as early as June 27th at 1:00 PM for example, while the Cubscout cubmobile registration and race begin at 4:00 PM on Sunday, June 30th in the rear parking lot of St. Tobias Church. Catch a range of acts, spanning from big names to local favorites at some of these locations; while others on the list keep it close and personal, hosting open mic events and accoustic entertainment.







During Summer, hike the park's 17 miles of trails or swim in Parker Lake's cool waters. Autumn brings a fusion of color beautiful to behold while Winter offers cross country skiing or ice fishing. Come Spring, look forward to participating in the maple sugaring process. Rustic cabins are available throughout the year for those of you who want a roof, but sleeping under the stars is also an option should that be your dream.

Quehanna Wild Area

Quehanna's two State Forest natural areas – the Wykoff Run Natural Area (1215 acres) and the Marion Brooks Natural Area (917 acres) provide you with ample opportunity to hike, camp and fish in nature's loveliest spot. Covering parts of Cameron, Clearfield and Elk Counties, Quehanna is the largest state forest wild area in Pennsylvania. Here you'll see amazing flora and fauna, including herds of native Elk as they traverse a second growth forest of hardwoods and evergreens. Take a breath. Spend the day.

Rock Run Recreation Area

In rural northern Cambria and southern Clearfield Counties you'll find 70 miles of hiking, ATV, UTV and dirt bike trails that take you to the most beautiful Allegheny Mountain views found anywhere in the State. Bring your hiking boots, your dirt bike or your machine and experience everything that Pennsylvania nature has to offer. Oh, and bring your camera, too. You don't want to miss this.

Shagger's Inn


Shagger's Inn is an impounded wetland that supports wildlife not often seen elsewhere. Somewhat secluded in its locations, Shagger's Inn offers a peaceful place to canoe, kayak, fish and picnic. Waterfowl are present in the Spring and Fall, while white-tailed deer, black bears, beavers and wild turkeys can also be found here. Perhaps most exciting though, is that Shagger's Inn is one of the few remaining Pennsylvania nesting areas for the elusive wild Osprey.

Simon B. Elliot State Park

Like a fish with a bit of fight? If so, Simon B. Elliot State Park might be a destination of choice for you. Offering a combination of native and stocked trout that can only be found by hiking through the trails leading to the park's mountain streams, Simon B. (as it is affectionately called), is a fisherperson's delight.


